

## **FOYLE, CARLINGFORD AND IRISH LIGHTS COMMISSION (FCILC) SECTOR**

### **RECORD OF DECISION - IP/FCILC 1**

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, the Rt. Hon. Paul Murphy, M.P., Secretary of State for Northern Ireland and Mr. Dermot Ahern, T.D., Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources have given consent to the decision sought in **Paper IP/ FCILC1**. The decision was made on 29 January 2003 and the appointments are effective from 13 December 2002.

#### **Decision Sought in Paper IP/FCILC1**

Ministers are invited to:

- (a) Agree that the persons listed in Annex A should be appointed to the Board of the Foyle, Carlingford and Irish Lights Commission;
- (b) Agree that these persons should be appointed to the Board from 13 December 2002 to 12 December 2005; and
- (c) Agree that Mr. Peter Savage and Lord Cooke of Islandreagh should be reappointed Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson, respectively.
