

## **RECORD OF DECISION – IP/FCILC 4**

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, Mr Ian Pearson, M.P., Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Mr. Dermot Ahern, T.D., Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources have given consent to the decision sought in **Paper IP/FCILC 4**. The effective date of this decision is 15 October 2003.

### **Decision Sought in Paper IP/FCILC 4**

Ministers are invited to give their approval for the Loughs Agency to recruit a consultancy to carry out the proposed “study to examine the development potential of marine related tourism and recreational activities in both Carlingford Lough and Lough Foyle and the role of the Loughs Agency in promoting that development.
