

RECORD OF DECISION – IP/FS 6

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, Ms Angela Smith, M.P., Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Mr. Micheál Martin, T.D., Minister for Health and Children have given consent to the decision in Paper **IP/FS 6**. The effective date of this decision is 18 December 2003.

- (a) approve the Food Safety Promotion Board's Business Plan for 2004;
- (b) recommend the budget provision for the Food Safety Promotion Board in the table below for 2004, including the respective Northern Ireland and Southern contributions; and
