### **BUSINESS PLAN FOR 2007**

#### **RECORD OF DECISION/IP TOU 29**

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, The Rt. Hon. Peter Hain, M.P., Secretary of State for Northern Ireland and Mr. John O'Donoghue, T.D., Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism have given consent to the decision sought in **Paper IP/TOU 29**. The effective date of this decision is 25 March 2007.

#### **Decision Sought in Paper IP/TOU 29**

Ministers are asked to:

- (i) approve the Tourism Ireland Business Plan for 2007;
- (ii) recommend the core budget provision for Tourism Ireland in the table above for 2007, including the respective Northern Ireland and Southern contributions; and
- (iii) note that additional resources will be sought in-year in the normal way.
