TWO 99 YEAR LEASES OF RIVER SHANNON FRONTAGE AT COOTHALL, CO ROSCOMMON TO MRS MAURA DOHERTY

RECORD OF DECISION/IP WI 22

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, Ms Maria Eagle, Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Mr. Éamon Ó Cuív, T.D., Minister for Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs have given consent to the decision sought in **Paper IP/ WI 22**. The effective date of this decision is 20 November 2006.

Decision Sought in Paper IP/WI 22

Ministers are asked to approve the disposal of two areas of River Shannon frontage at Coothall, Co Roscommon measuring approximately 3,038 sq metres and 4,063 sq metres by two leases for 99 years to Mrs Maura Doherty to facilitate the construction of a 24 berth marina and to regularise the existence of a 40 berth marina.
