LEASE OF PART OF A WATERWAY TO DUBLIN DOCKLANDS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WALKWAY STRUCTURE AT GRAND CANAL PLAZA

RECORD OF DECISION/IP WI 27

Pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing a North/South Ministerial Council done at Dublin on 8 March 1999, the Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland establishing Implementation Bodies done at Dublin on 8 March 1999 and to the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of letters dated 18 June 1999, as amended by the supplementary Agreement between the Government of Ireland and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the exchange of notes dated 19 November 2002, Ms Maria Eagle, M.P., Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Mr Éamon Ó Cuív, T.D., Minister for Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs have given consent to the decision sought in **Paper IP/WI 27**. The effective date of this decision is 10 February 2007.

Decision Sought in Paper IP/WI 27

Ministers are asked to approve of the disposal of an area of 415m² of the waterbody of Grand Canal Dock by lease for 99 years to Dublin Docklands Development Authority to facilitate the construction of a walkway structure from the Grand Canal Theatre, extending into the waterbody.
